While Rick is known throughout the country for his paintings, he is also an accomplished writer. A graduate of the University of Colorado School of Journalism, Rick gained a solid reputation as a journalist, writing for the award-winning weekly *Vineyard Gazette* on Martha's Vineyard, as well as the *Cape Cod Times* and *The Boston Globe*. His writing has also appeared in *The New York Times*, *Adweek's Brandweek* and *The Village Voice*.
