## Art Talks & Painting Demonstrations

Sunday, July 6, 1:00 - 2:00 Demonstration and Talk  
"Behind the Scenes" with **Joan Brancale**. Joan will explain how her theatre training influences her work process and its narrative element: having a painting idea and developing its concept and design before beginning a painting. Visuals will include a work-in-process, its supporting materials as well as stories behind some paintings in the gallery. Joan will also present examples of her theatre design renderings and costume designs.

"My painting demonstration will focus on several key points that I am constantly thinking about when I am working on a painting. The first and most important step that will be discussed is composition. The overall design of the painting is the first thing that will catch the viewer's eye. Good design is visible in successful paintings, whether they are realistic or abstract. Color, value and drawing will also be covered. The conversation during the demo will be helpful to the artist as well as the art collector."

"Plein Air Painting from Scratch" with **Alice Mongeau**  
The artist will discuss choosing a subject, editing and transcribing a vista onto a canvas, and knowing when her paintings are finished. With almost 30 years of experience painting *al fresco*, Alice will also share some of her secrets concerning dealing with interruptions from bugs, rain and pedestrians.

Friday, July 25, 4:00 - 5:00

"Connecting with the Landscape" with **Mary Moquin**  
"There is a sense of centeredness, stability, solitude, and a prevailing unity with the eternal rhythms of nature that I am exploring in my work. My paintings explore the places that I am deeply connected with and have found renewal in. These are the places where I am most united with the energy force that orchestrates this universe. Please join me for a visual presentation and discussion that will explore the sources I draw on for creating my paintings."

"The Copley Society: Yesterday and Today"  
Gallery Talk with **Elizabeth Pratt**  
When Elizabeth arrived in Boston in 1979, the Copley and the Boston art scene was rapidly bringing itself out of conservatism. She will speak about the Copley's transition from a small group of illustrious artists to the formidable broad organization it has become.
